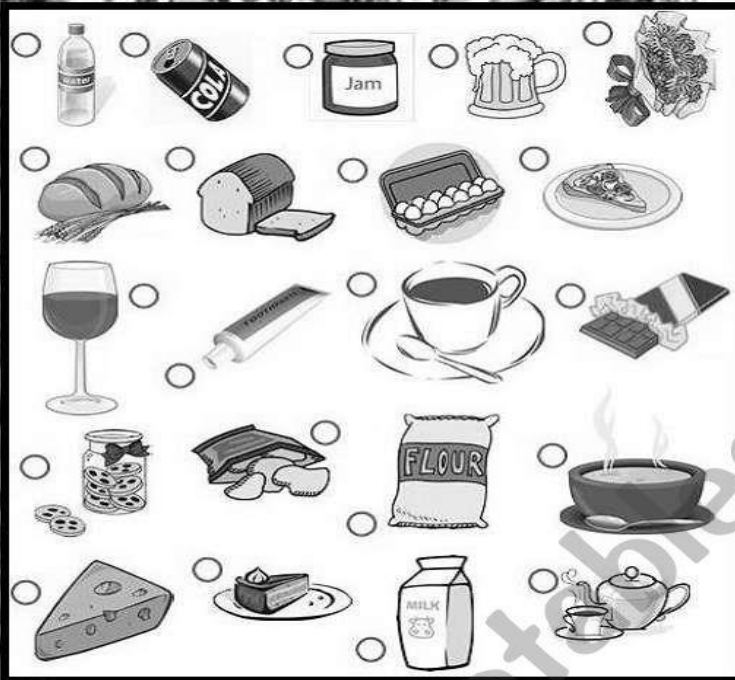

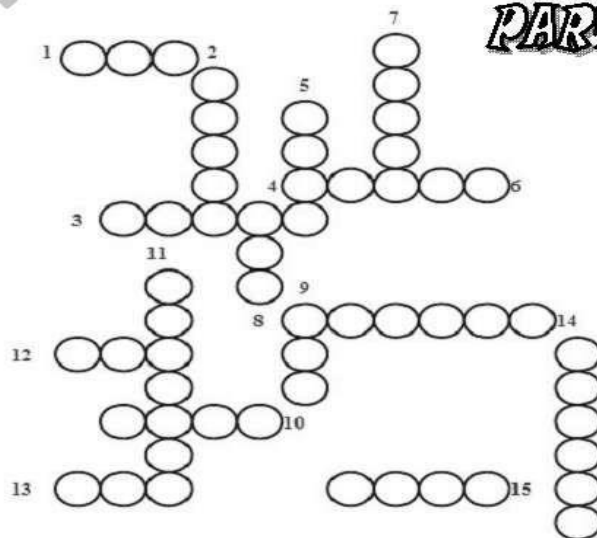

Singular

A banana / a biscuit

Plural

3 bananas / 4 biscuits

- Use **a / an** with singular nouns.

"**a**" is used with consonant sounds and "**An**" with vowel sounds.

A banana

an apple

- Use **SOME** with plural countable nouns:

I have **some** bananas

I have **some** biscuits

Uncountable Nouns

Bread, Cheese, milk and Orange juice are uncountable nouns , so **NO s**

~~Breads~~ ~~cheeses~~ ~~milks~~ ~~orange juices~~

I have **some** bread

We have **some** milk.

The **verb** is **singular** with uncountable nouns.

Bread **is** cheap This milk **is** cold

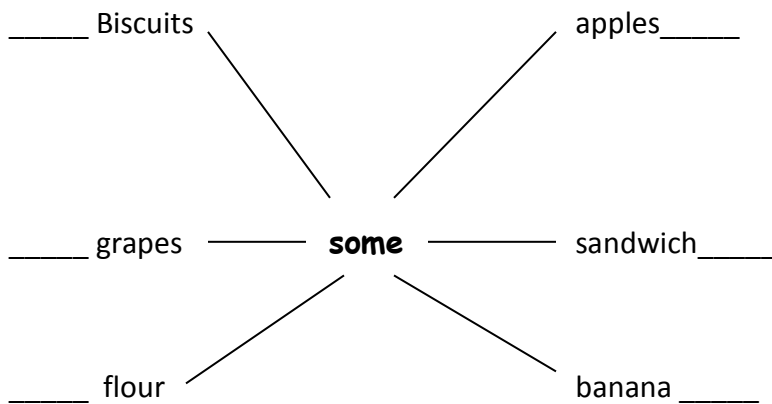
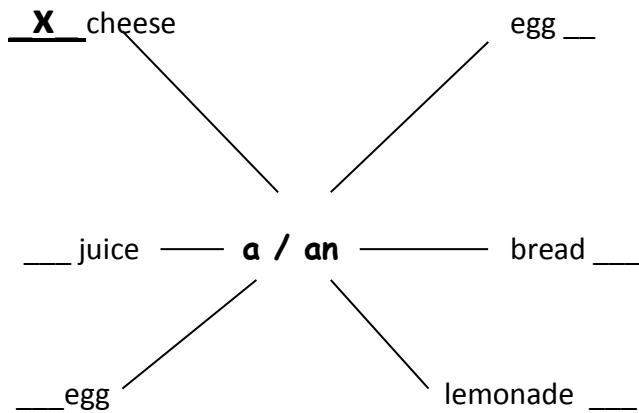
